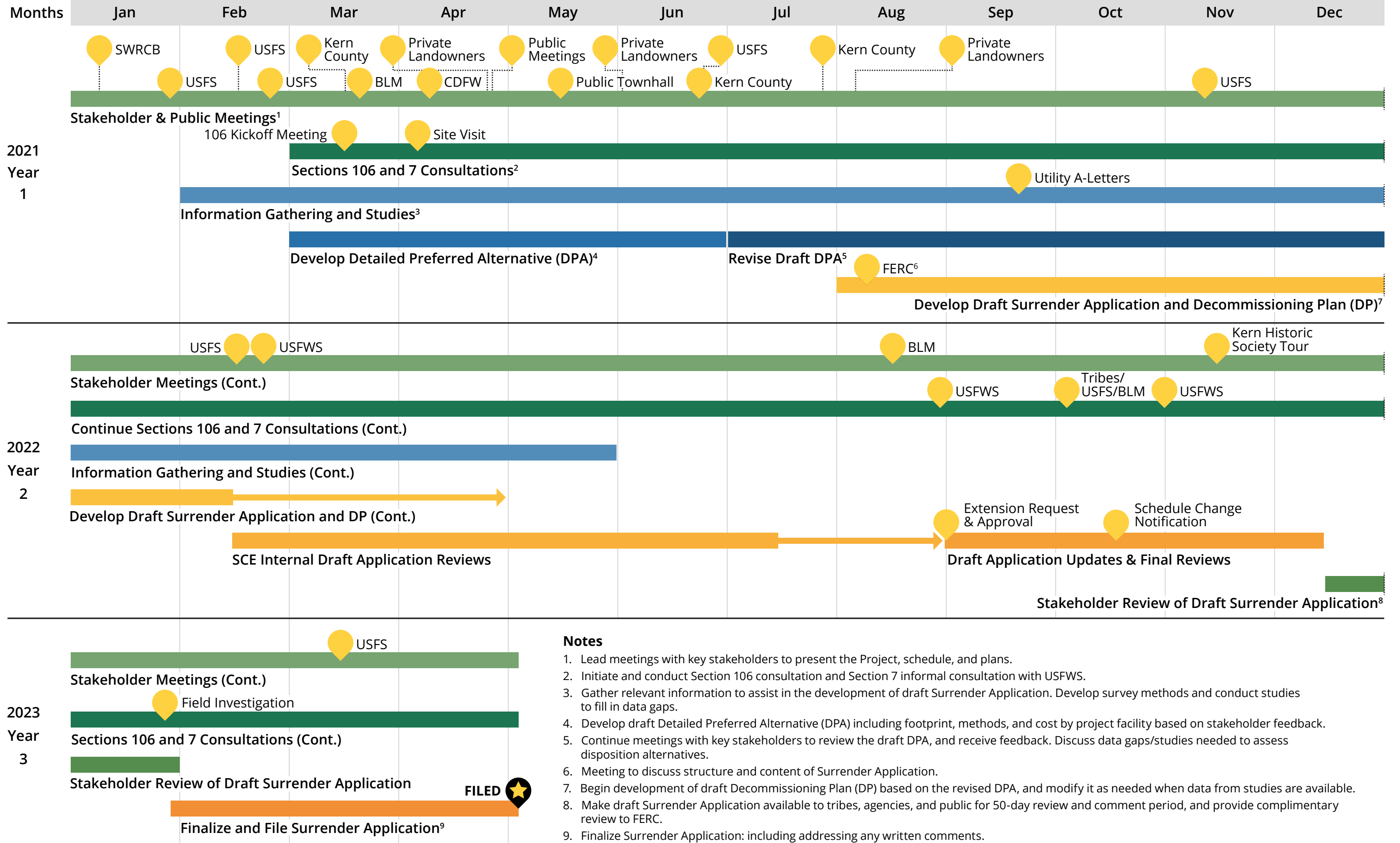

# Borel Hydroelectric Project (FERC Project No. 382)

## License Surrender Application



### Notes

1. Lead meetings with key stakeholders to present the Project, schedule, and plans.
2. Initiate and conduct Section 106 consultation and Section 7 informal consultation with USFWS.
3. Gather relevant information to assist in the development of draft Surrender Application. Develop survey methods and conduct studies to fill in data gaps.
4. Develop draft Detailed Preferred Alternative (DPA) including footprint, methods, and cost by project facility based on stakeholder feedback.
5. Continue meetings with key stakeholders to review the draft DPA, and receive feedback. Discuss data gaps/studies needed to assess disposition alternatives.
6. Meeting to discuss structure and content of Surrender Application.
7. Begin development of draft Decommissioning Plan (DP) based on the revised DPA, and modify it as needed when data from studies are available.
8. Make draft Surrender Application available to tribes, agencies, and public for 50-day review and comment period, and provide complimentary review to FERC.
9. Finalize Surrender Application: including addressing any written comments.
